

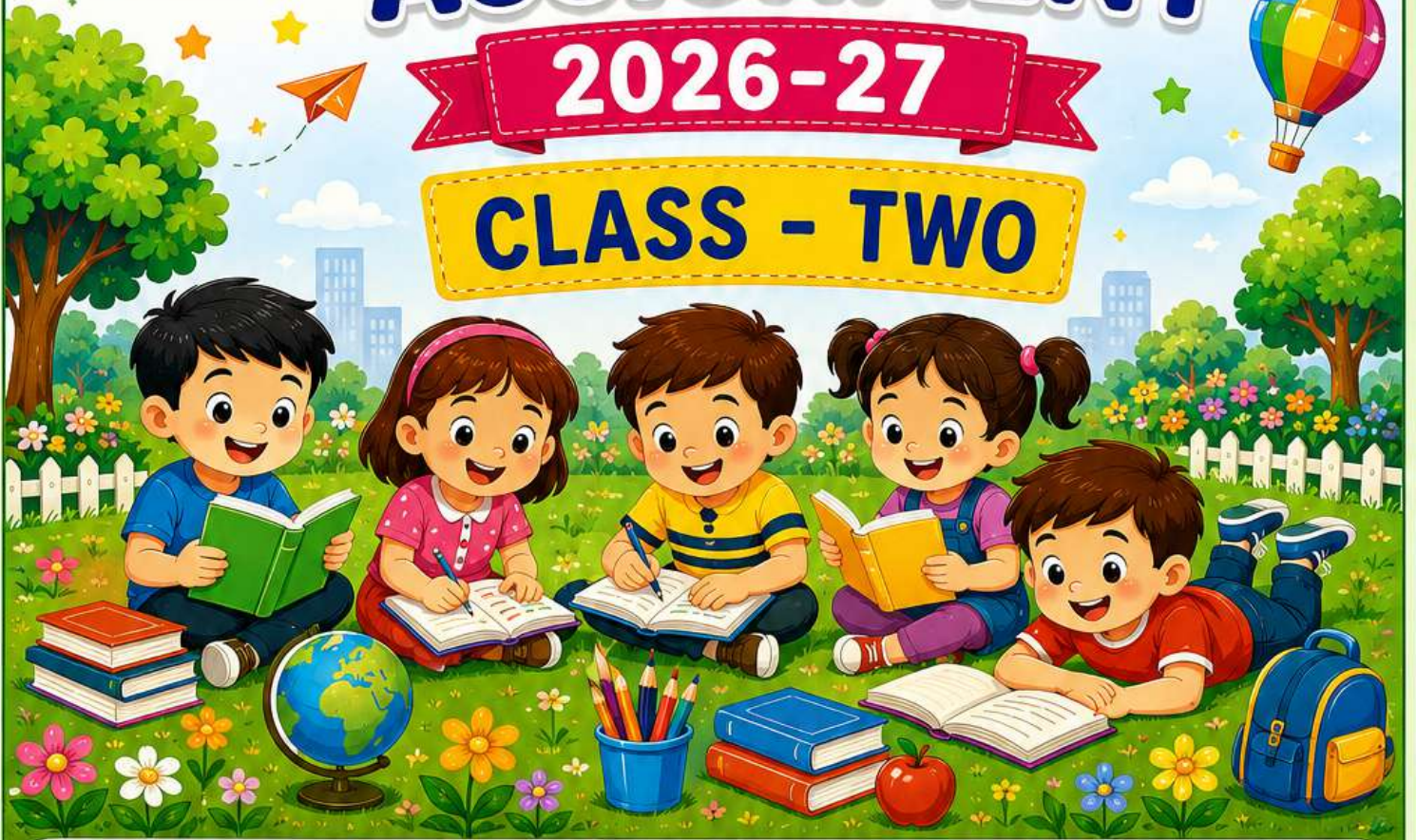

Wishing you all a safe, happy, and fruitful vacation!

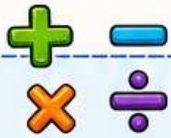

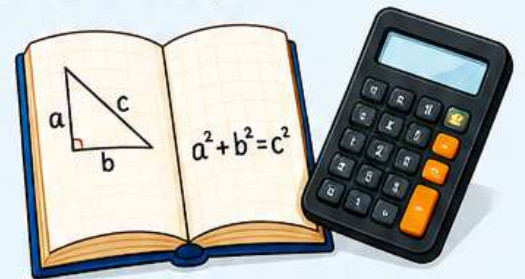


- 1 Write counting from 101 to 200. (In Maths notebook)

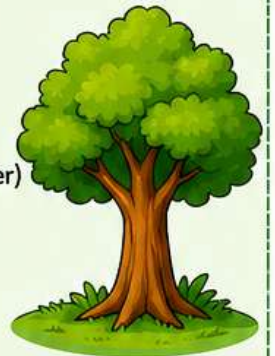
