

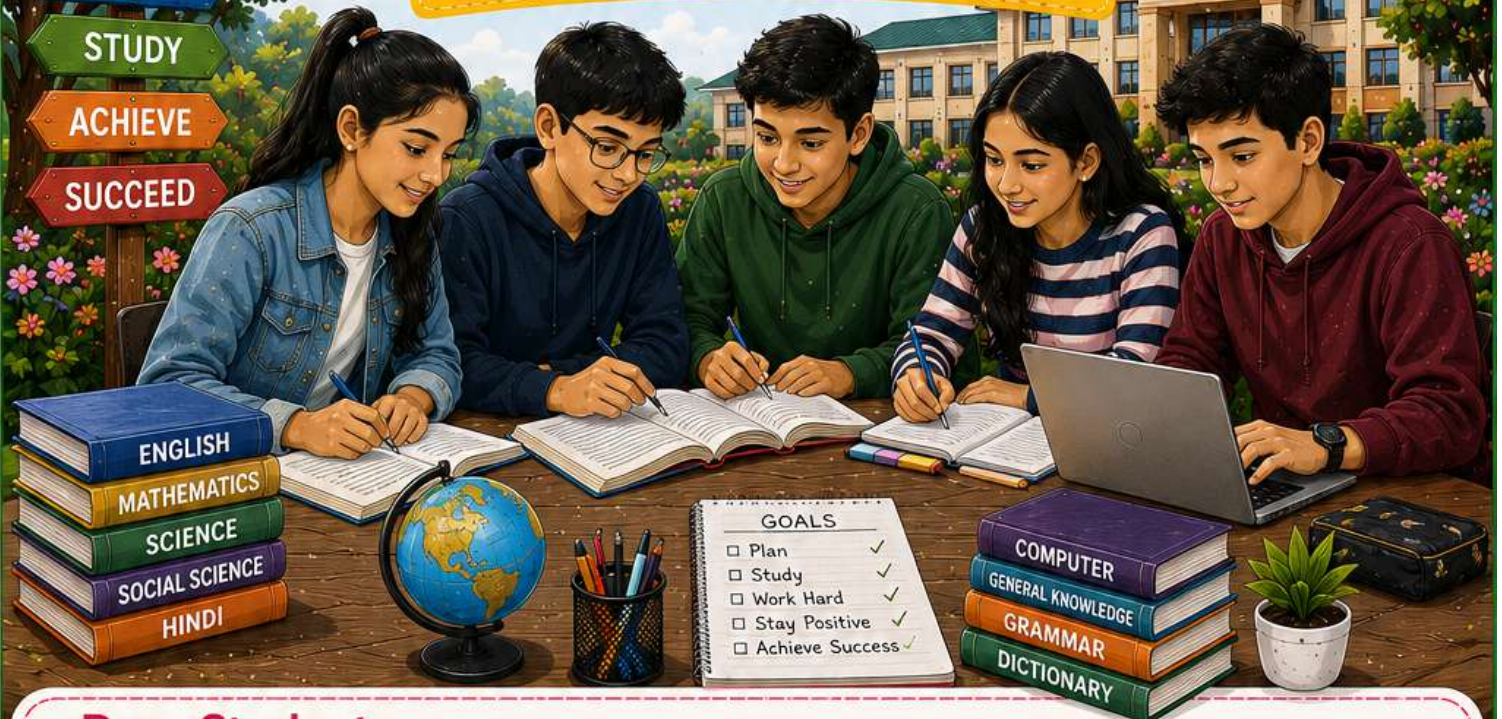

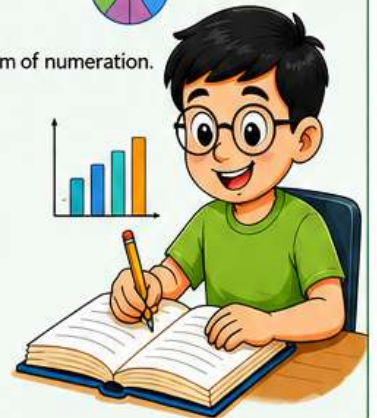

- 9 Solve all problem of Chapter 1, 2, 3 and 4 from Maths Book in your Notebook.



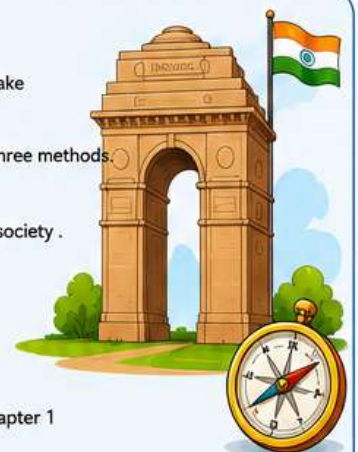
